- participate in the business development effort

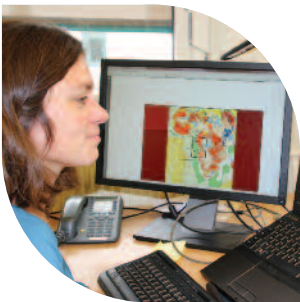
